ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

NOTICE OF INTENTION

VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to allow highway maintenance, improvement and drainage work to be carried out in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

(1) WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become necessary.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

(2) PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto.

(3) ONE-WAY WORKING

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto, in a direction other than that indicated by traffic signs.

NB: During the prohibitions at (2) and (3) above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate.

NB: The above prohibitions at (3) will not apply to cul-de-sacs.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 22nd April 2013 with no specified finish date.
4. THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate
6. NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works.

NOTICE OF PROPOSAL

1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to enable the holding of the St Christopher's Hospice Fun Walk in Commonside Keston on Sunday 19th May 2013 between 8am and 8pm, THEY PROPOSE to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions: -
 - (i) The following roads will be closed to through traffic:-
 - (a) Commonside between Heathfield Road and Oakfield Lane
 - (b) Fishponds Road
 - (ii) No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to wait in the following roads:-

Commonside, between Oakfield Lane and Croydon Road
Heathfield Road
Baston Road between Commonside and Croydon Road
West Common Road between Commonside and Croydon Road
Baston Manor Road between West Common Road and Croydon Road
Westerham Road, the west side between Fishponds Road and Croydon Road
2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect at 8am on Sunday 19th May 2013 and will end at 8pm.
4. THE Metropolitan Police have been consulted and are in agreement.
