ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED - SECTION 14 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

- THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to allow highway maintenance, improvement and drainage work to be carried out in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
 - (1) WAITING VEHICLES
 - No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become necessary.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

- PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
 - No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street adjacent thereto.
- ONE-WAY WORKING
- No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street adjacent thereto, in a direction other than that indicated by traffic signs.
- NB: During the prohibitions at (2) and (3) above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate.

NB: The above prohibition at (3) will not apply to cul-de-sacs.

- 2. THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
 - THE Order will come into effect on Monday 31st March 2014 with
- no specified finish date.
- THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, and will begin on or after the date of the Order.
- ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate.
- NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers.

(VARIOUS LOCATIONS)

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) introduce/extend waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice:
- prohibit vehicles travelling in a northerly direction along Cray Avenue, Orpington from performing a U-Turn at its junction with the entrance to the Nugent Shopping Park;
- amend the hours of operation of the existing loading bay in Kingsdale Road, Penge from Monday to Saturday 7am to 7pm to Monday to Saturday 10am to 5pm with a maximum waiting time of 10 minutes and no return within 1 hour;
- formalise existing school keep clear markings as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- remove one Pay and Display bay outside the side entrance to Uno Apartments Sherman Road, Bromley and replace with Mon-Sat 8.30am-6.30pm and Sun 10am-5pm waiting restrictions:
- introduce one additional Pay and Display bay outside the main entrance to Uno Apartments Sherman Road, Bromley;
- remove the Permit holder bay outside Nos. 5 & 7 Pope Road, Bromley;
- replace the two disabled bays outside Nos. 264 & 266 High Street, Orpington with two Pay and Display bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice:
- amend the waiting restriction Order to reflect the current position on-street at the junction of Amesbury Road and Page Heath Lane, Bromley;
- amend the waiting restriction Order to reflect the change of street name of Ramsden Road (part of), Orpington to Old Priory Avenue;
- introduce new disabled parking bays as specified in the
- Schedule to this notice;
- (I) remove the disabled parking bays as specified in the Schedule

Details of prohibitions and exemptions for certain vehicles and persons are contained in the original Orders.

A copy of the proposed orders, of the plans of the schemes and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent.

Persons objecting to the proposed orders should be aware that under the provisions of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, any comments received in response to this Notice may be open to public inspection.

No Waiting At Any Time:-AMESBURY ROAD, Bromley, (a) the west side, from the northern kerbline of

Page Heath Lane northwards for a distance of 15m; (b) the east side, from the northern kerbline of Page Heath Lane northwards for a distance of 9m

MANOR PARK CLOSE. West Wickham, both sides, from the south eastern kerbline of Manor Park Road south eastwards for a distance of 10m.

MANOR PARK ROAD, West Wickham, the south east side, from a point 10m north east of the north eastern kerbline of Manor Park Close south westwards to a point 10m south west of the south western kerbline of Manor Park Close.

OLD PRIORY AVENUE, Orpington, the north side, from the western kerbline of Court Road westwards for a distance of 14m.
