- THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE
  that in order that a new development can be constructed on the site at
  the corner of Nichol Lane and Burnt Ash Lane Bromley THEY INTEND
  to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following
  restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
  - (1) PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

Nichol Lane Bromley will be closed to through traffic between the junctions with Croft Road and Burnt Ash Lane.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-Croft Road

Burnt Ash Lane

Bromley BR1 3UH

(2) WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in Nichol Lane Bromley, both sides for a distance of 30 metres from the junction with Burnt Ash Lane.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

- THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- THE Order will come into effect on Monday 28th July 2014 with no specified finish date.
- THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, and it is expected that the actual works will take 3 months to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
- ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate
- 6. NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works.
