3. THE Order will come into effect on Saturday 4th October 2014 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to 5 months to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate.
6. THE Metropolitan Police Traffic Management Team has been consulted and is in agreement.
7. NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works.
