1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order that BT customer connections can be made THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
Layhams Road Keston will be closed to through traffic in the vicinity of Highview. Displaced traffic will be diverted via:- King Henry's Drive, Lodge Lane, Kent Gate Way, Addington Road

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED – Section 14

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC THICKET ROAD AND ORCHARD GROVE PENCE NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that because works are proposed to be executed near the road on the site of Crystal Palace Railway Station, in order to provide access and egress for heavy crane and delivery of materials to site THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

No stopping at any time.

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to stop in Thicket Road from a point in line with the party wall of number 22 and number 24 Thicket Road extending 55 metres north-eastwards and in Orchard Grove from the northwest kerb line of Thicket Road extending north-westwards for 50 metres.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Saturday 29th November 2014 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take six months to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
