TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

- THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to allow building works to be carried out at Harris Academy, Lennard Road Beckenham in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
 - (1) WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become necessary. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street adjacent thereto.

or any other street adjact (3) ONE-WAY WORKING

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Order, or any other street adjacent thereto, in a direction other than that indicated by traffic signs.

NB: During the prohibitions at (2) and (3) above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate.

NB: The above prohibition at (3) will not apply to cul-de-sacs.

- THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- 3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 12th January 2015 with no specified finish date.
- 4. THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, and will begin on or after the date of the Order.
- ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate.
- NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works.
- 7. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or Traffic Warden
