NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley
on 12th May 2015 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49
and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as
amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act
1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on
25th May 2015.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) introduce/extend/amend waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;**
- (b) introduce a Controlled Parking Zone scheme, Monday to Friday 9am to 5pm, as specified in the Schedule to this notice.**

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays
to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the
expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.
ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their
provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling
Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations
made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on
which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE
that in order to allow Pre-Fabricated classrooms to be transported to
site in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY INTEND to make
an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions
on vehicular traffic:-

WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any
vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice,
or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become
necessary.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting
imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the
Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council
in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only
during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be
indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations
