NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

- The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order that carriageway repairs can be carried out in Parish Lane Penge THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop in Parish Lane Penge between the junctions of Tennyson Road and Edward Road between the hours of 9.30am and 4.00pm.

The Disabled Bay in Parish Lane opposite the junction with Victor Road is suspended for the duration of the works
- THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- THE Order will come into effect on Monday 22nd June 2015 with no specified finish date.
- ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take one day to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.

NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

- The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order that new classrooms can be installed at Parish Church of England Primary School, London Lane, Bromley THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

London Lane Bromley will be closed to through traffic.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-
Burnt Ash Lane
Park Avenue
Kinnaird Avenue
- THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- THE Order will come into effect on Saturday 20th June 2015 with no specified finish date.
- ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take two weekends to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.

The Bromley (Controlled Parking) (On Street Places) Order 2004 (Amendment No. **) Order 2015.
The Bromley (Prohibition of Stopping on Cab Ranks) Traffic Order 1990 (Amendment No. **) Order 2015
The Bromley (Prescribed Route) (No. *) (One Way) Order 2015.
(Elmfield Park and Elmfield Road, Bromley)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- introduce a One-Way system as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- remove the two sections of 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions on the western side of Elmfield Road outside No. 26 and replace with 7 additional Pay & Display parking spaces;
- extend the existing southernmost parking place on the western side of Elmfield Road outside No. 28 by 6m at its southern end (1 additional parking space);
- extend the existing parking place on the eastern side of Elmfield Road outside Nos. 33 to 39 by 7m at its southern end (1 additional parking spaces);
- remove the single parking space near No. 2 York House, Elmfield Park and replace with Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm and Sunday 10am-5pm waiting restrictions;
- extend the existing parking place on the southern side of Palace View, near its junction with Elmfield Road, by 6m at its western end (1 additional parking space);
- introduce new parking places and taxi ranks as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- remove the 2 existing taxi ranks on the western side of Elmfield Park and the existing taxi rank on the eastern side of Elmfield Park (north to south arm) and replace with Monday to Saturday 8.30am-6.30pm and Sunday 10am-5pm waiting restrictions;
- extend the existing taxi rank on the southern side of Elmfield Park (southernmost west to east arm) by 15m at its eastern end;
- introduce waiting and loading restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Details of prohibitions and exemptions for certain vehicles and persons are contained in the original Orders.

A copy of the proposed orders, of the plans of the schemes and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent.

ANY person wishing to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Executive Director of Environment and Community Services, Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, BR1 3UH, quoting reference ADE(TP)/RP/T/100/618 not later than 8th July 2015. Persons objecting to the proposed orders should be aware that under the provisions of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, any comments received in response to this Notice may be open to public inspection.

SCHEDULE:-
ONE WAY SYSTEM

ELMFIELD PARK, Bromley, (a) between the southern kerbline of the northernmost west to east arm of Elmfield Park and the northern kerbline of the southernmost west to east arm of Elmfield Park in a northerly to southerly direction; (b) the southernmost west to east arm, between the eastern kerbline of the north to south arm of Elmfield Park and the western kerbline of Elmfield Road in a westerly to easterly direction.

ELMFIELD ROAD, Bromley, between the southernmost junction with Elmfield Park and the northernmost junction with Elmfield Park in a southerly to northerly direction.

PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

Pay and Display parking between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, and between 10am and 5pm on Sundays except Public Holidays and Bank Holidays. £1.70p per hour – 2 hours maximum stay:-

ELMFIELD PARK, Bromley, the north to south arm, the east side, (i) from a point 6m south of a point opposite the southern flank wall of York House northwards for a distance of 23m (4 parking spaces); (ii) from a point 9.5m north of the northern kerbline of the southernmost west to east arm of Elmfield Park north westwards for a distance of 15.5m (3 parking spaces).

ELMFIELD ROAD, Bromley, the north to south arm, the east side, from a point 1m south of the common boundary of Nos. 19 & 21-23 southwards for a distance of 15m (3 parking spaces).

TAXI RANKS

No stopping between midnight and 8.30am and between 6.30pm and midnight on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, and between midnight and 10am and between 5pm and midnight on Sundays, except taxis:-

ELMFIELD PARK, Bromley, the north to south arm, the east side, from a point 9.5m north of the northern kerbline of the southernmost west to east arm of Elmfield Park north westwards for a distance of 15.5m.

WAITING AND LOADING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting or Loading 'At Any Time':-

ELMFIELD PARK, Bromley, the northernmost west to east arm, the south side, from the western kerbline of Elmfield Road westwards and southwards to the northern kerbline of the access to No. 1 Elmfield Park.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 9th June 2015 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 22nd June 2015.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- introduce/amend waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- amend the Permit Holder Only bays in Woodland Way, Petts Wood to Pay & Display bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- amend the Permit Holder Only bays in Petts Wood Road, Petts Wood to Shared Use bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- remove sections of Pay and Display parking spaces, outside St. Paul's Villa, Park Road, Beckenham, and replace with Monday to Friday 8am–6.30pm waiting restrictions, as result of vehicle crossover installations;
- extend the Beckenham Controlled Parking Zone (Zone BEC) to include that section of Fairfield Road between Christ Church Road and Burnhill Road;
- introduce resident permit bays in Fairfield Road, Beckenham as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- introduce a taxi rank as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE:-
WAITING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

CROFTON ROAD, Orpington, the north side, from a point opposite a point 25m east of the eastern kerbline of Orchard Green westwards to a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 9 & 11.

FOREST RIDGE, Beckenham, (a) the north side, (i) from the south eastern kerbline of Kelsey Lane eastwards to the party wall of Nos. 1 & 3; (ii) from the western kerbline of Greenways westwards for a distance of 10m; (b) the south side, (i) from the south eastern kerbline of Kelsey Lane eastwards to a point 1m west of the party wall of Nos. 2 & 4; (ii) from the western kerbline of Greenways westwards for a distance of 6m.

GREENWAYS, Beckenham, the even numbered side, (i) from a point 7m south of the common boundary of Nos. 34 & 36 southwards to its junction with the southern arm of Uplands; (ii) from a point 10m north of the northern kerbline of Forest Ridge southwards to a point 10m south of the southern kerbline of Forest Ridge.

KELSEY LANE, Beckenham, (a) the north west side, (i) from the common boundary of Nos. 75 & 77 Village Way north eastwards to the common boundary of Nos. 73 & 75 Village Way; (ii) from the southern kerbline of Uplands south westwards for a distance of 10m; (b) the south east side, (i) from the northern kerbline of Forest Ridge north eastwards for a distance of 8m; (ii) from the southern kerbline of Uplands south westwards for a distance of 10m.

UPLANDS, Beckenham, (a) the north side, (i) from the eastern kerbline of Village Way eastwards for a distance of 18m; (ii) from a point 3m east of the party wall of Nos. 5 & 7 eastwards to a point 13m east of the eastern kerbline of Kelsey Lane; (iii) from a point 6m south of the northern boundary of No. 23 northwards to the western kerbline of Greenways; (b) the south side, (i) from the eastern kerbline of Village Way eastwards for a distance of 18m; (ii) from the common boundary of Nos. 2 & 4 eastwards to a point 3m west of the common boundary of Nos. 8 & 10; (iii) from a point 1m west of the common boundary of Nos. 24 & 26 eastwards to a point 1m west of the eastern boundary of No. 28; (c) the south east side of the northern arm, from the western kerbline of Greenways south westwards to the northern kerbline of the southern arm; (d) the north side of the southern arm, from the western kerbline of Greenways westwards to the south eastern kerbline of the northern arm.

No Waiting between 8.30am and 8.00pm throughout the week:-

BURNHILL ROAD, Beckenham, both sides, from the party wall of Nos. 5 & 6 eastwards to the south western kerbline of Kelsey Park Road.

FAIRFIELD ROAD, Beckenham, both sides, from the northern kerbline of Burnhill Road northwards to the party wall of Nos. 8 & 10.

No Waiting and No Loading between midnight and 9.30am and between 4pm and midnight throughout the week:-

HIGH STREET, Penge, the south west side, from a point 1m north west of the party wall of Nos. 72 & 74 south eastwards for a distance of 16m.

PAY AND DISPLAY PARKING PLACES

Pay and Display parking between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, except Public Holidays and Bank Holidays. 70p per hour – 2 hours maximum stay:-

WOODLAND WAY, Petts Wood, the south west side, from a point 5m south east of the southern boundary of No. 1 south eastwards for a distance of 38m (7 parking spaces).

SHARED USE PARKING PLACES

Pay and Display parking between 8.30am and 6.30pm on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive, except Public Holidays and Bank Holidays. 70p per hour – 2 hours maximum stay. Permit holders may park during the permitted hours with no additional charge:-

PETTS WOOD ROAD, Petts Wood, the south west side, from a point 4m south east of the north western corner nearest Petts Wood Railway Station south eastwards for a distance of 8m (4 parking spaces).

RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING

Permit holders only between 8.30am and 8pm throughout the week. Zone BEC. Residents Permits £80 per annum per vehicle:-

FAIRFIELD ROAD, Beckenham, the west side, from the party wall of Nos. 8 & 10 southwards for a distance of 15m (3 parking spaces).

TAXI RANK

No Stopping At Any Time, except taxis:-

CROFTON ROAD, Orpington, the north side, from a point opposite the common boundary of Nos. 9 & 11 eastwards for a distance of 15m.
