BROMLEY COURT HOTEL CONISTON ROAD BROMLEY BR1 4JD - (15/02452)

Hybrid Planning Application comprising Full Planning Permission for demolition of the existing plant rooms and refurbishment of the existing hotel including part one/three/four/five storey extensions and elevational alterations to provide function room, meeting rooms, beauty salon, kitchens, additional bedrooms, energy centre, staff accommodation and offices together with Outline Planning Permission for the erection of a new leisure centre (including gym, activity room and swimming pool) as well as alterations to the existing access and increased parking provision (total 92 spaces).

THE STUDIO PLAWSFIELD ROAD BECKENHAM BR3 1JD - (15/03199)

Elevational alterations, single storey side extension and conversion of existing office building to 3 bedroom residential dwelling. which falls within the Barnmead Road Conservation Area, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance

40 YESTER ROAD CHISLEHURST BR7 5HR - (15/02969)

Two storey side extension, elevational alterations and internal works. which falls within the Chislehurst Conservation Area, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance

172 HIGH STREET BECKENHAM BR3 1EW - (15/03300)

Installation of electronically operated roller shutters to shopfront. which falls within the Beckenham Town Centre Conservation Area, the character or appearance of which it is desirable to preserve or enhance

ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED – Section 14 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC OAK GROVE ROAD PENGES

NOTICE OF INTENTION

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order that new drainage can be installed to a new development THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Oak Grove Road Penges will be closed to through traffic. No person shall cause or permit any vehicle to stop in Oak Grove Road Penges between 16 Oak Grove Road and 26 Oak Grove Road on both sides of the street.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Croydon Road
Elmers End Road
Ash Grove

Access to properties in Oak Grove Road will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate. Access to Tramway Close will be available at the Ash Grove/Chesham Road junction into Oak Grove Road.

2. THE Order will come into effect on Tuesday 1st September 2015 with no specified finish date.

3. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.

4. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works

5. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take two weeks to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.

6. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
