NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Thames Water to disconnect a water supply for the former Dripping Tap site on Masons Hill THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:

Traffic will be banned from turning right out of Homesdale Road Bromley into Masons Hill for one weekend.

Traffic wanting to turn right onto Masons Hill will be diverted via Bromley Common to the Crown Lane Spur roundabout, where motorists will turn round and travel back down to Masons Hill.

- 2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

NOTICE OF INTENTION VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to allow highway maintenance and junction improvements to be carried out in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

(1) WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice. or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

(2) PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto.

(3) ONE-WAY WORKING

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto, in a direction other than that indicated by traffic signs.

During the prohibitions at (2) and (3) above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate. NB:

The above prohibitions at (3) will not apply to cul-de-sacs.

- 2. THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
- 3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 19th October 2015 with no specified finish date.
- 4. THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, and the works will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from
