THE Order will come into effect on Friday 30th October 2015 with no specified finish date.

on or after the commencement date of the Order.

NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.

to follow and adhere to the diversion and signs on site.

7. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
