**CROWN LANE CHISLEHURST**  
**NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for BT to install a new customer service THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Crown Lane Chislehurst will be closed to through traffic for one day.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Morley Road

Hawkwood Lane

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Friday 30th October 2015 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to one day to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.
6. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
7. ACCESS to properties in Crown Lane Chislehurst will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate.

**NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order that Thames Water can repair a broken water main THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Saltbox Hill Biggin Hill will be closed to northbound traffic travelling towards Jewels Hill at the junction with Main Road for two consecutive nights.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Main Road

Lebanon Gardens

Stock Hill

Norheads Lane

Oaklands Lane

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 2nd November 2015 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take two consecutive nights to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.
6. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times but vehicles will need to follow and adhere to the diversion and signs on site.
7. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
