ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED – Section 14 TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC WELLBROOK ROAD FARNBOROUGH NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Thames Water to repair a carriageway defect THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Wellbrook Road Farnborough will be closed to through traffic for one day.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Hilda Vale Road
Starts Hill Road

2. The prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Sunday 29th November 2015 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to one day to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.
6. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
7. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times, however vehicles will need to follow the diversion signs displayed on site.

Appeal against refusal of planning permission for demolition of all school buildings, with the exception of the Reception building and the Stable block, and erection of 48 dwellings comprising 24x4 bed houses, 16x1 bed flats and 8x 2 bed flats and conversion of the stable block into 2x2 bed residential units, together with 108 car parking spaces. Associated landscaping, hardstanding areas, cycle stores and bin stores. Conversion of existing Reception building to 799sqm of office floorspace (Class b1A) together with 8 dedicated car parking spaces and the construction of 2 tennis courts, designated car park. Erection of pavilion and amenity area for community use.

DATE OF INQUIRY: 15th – 18th December 2015

VENUE: Committee Room 1, Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley

The Appeal is scheduled to last for 4 days. An Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State under paragraph 1 (1) of schedule 6 to the Town and Country Planning Act 1990 will attend to decide the appeal. Please note that the Planning Inspectorate aim to issue the decision within seven weeks of the Inquiry. The Inspector's decision will be published on the planning portal website.

Members of the public and interested parties may attend the Inquiry and at the Inspector's discretion give their views on the proposed development. The Bromley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2003
(Amendment No. 152) Order 2015.

The Bromley (Prescribed Route) (No. 4) (Banned Right Turn) Order 2015.
(Nichol Lane, Bromley)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 10th November 2015 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 1st December 2015.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) **introduce waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;**
- (b) **allow vehicles travelling in a southerly direction along Burnt Ash Lane, Bromley to turn left into Nichol Lane;**
- (c) **prohibit vehicles from turning right from Burnt Ash Lane, Bromley into Nichol Lane.**

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

BURNT ASH LANE, Bromley, the east side, from the northern kerbline of Plaistow Lane northwards to a point 7m south of the party wall of Nos. 2 & 4. NICHOL LANE, Bromley, (a) the north side, from the eastern kerbline of Burnt Ash Lane eastwards to a point 3m east of a point in line with the western flank wall of No. 2 Burnt Ash Lane; (b) the south side, from the eastern kerbline of Burnt Ash Lane eastwards to a point 1m east of the western flank wall of No. 55.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Thames Water to repair a faulty manhole cover THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

St Keverne Road Mottingham will be closed to through traffic for one day. The closure will be at the junction with Dunkery Road. The closure will take place during off peak hours to avoid school times.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

2. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 14th December 2015 with no specified finish date.
3. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
4. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works
5. ACCESS to properties in St Keverne Road will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate.
6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to one day to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
7. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
