TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC GREEN WAY BROMLEY NOTICE OF INTENTION

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Southern Gas Networks (SGN) to complete a gas main replacement project THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
Green Lane Bromley will be closed at the junction with Turpington Lane for up to four weeks to minimise traffic disruption.
Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-
Turpington Lane
Mons Way
Manor Way
Green Way
2. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 8th February 2016 with no specified finish date.
3. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
4. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times, however vehicles will need to follow the diversion signs displayed on site and access Green Way via Manor Way or Magpie Hall Lane.
6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to four weeks to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
7. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC SINGLE STREET BIGGIN HILL NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Southern Gas Networks to install a new gas supply to a property THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC UPPER ELMERS END ROAD BECKENHAM NOTICE OF INTENTION

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Network Rail to complete a survey on the railway bridge THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-
Upper Elmers End Beckenham will be closed to through traffic for one night. The section of road to be closed falls between the junctions of Links Way and South Eden Park Road (behind the petrol station).
The existing permanent Traffic Order which operates the movement of one way traffic within this section of Upper Elmers End Road Beckenham (between the junctions of Links Way and South Eden Park Road) will be suspended whilst the closure is in place and two way movements will be temporarily introduced during the works to enable access for residents at all times.

5. ACCESS to properties on this part of Upper Elmers End Road will be maintained as far as is practicable via the junction of South Eden Park Road.
6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to one night to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order. Works will start at 22.00 and complete by 06.00.
7. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Network Rail to complete essential maintenance on the railway bridge in Chislehurst Road Chislehurst THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

3. THE Order will come into effect on Friday 22nd January 2016 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to 3-4 months to complete (under weekend closures only) and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.
6. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
7. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times, however vehicles will need to follow the diversion signs displayed on site. The point of the closure is at the railway bridge in between the junctions of Station Approach and Denbridge Road.
