NOTICE OF PROPOSALS

1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to enable the holding of street parties on the specified dates THEY PROPOSE to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions:-

The following roads will be closed to through traffic at the times the signs are displayed between 8am and Midnight on Saturday 11th June 2016:

Biggin Hill

- Allenby Road – from a point level with the northern boundary of 45 Allenby Road to a point level with the southern boundary of 37 Allenby Road.

Bromley Common & Keston

- Fontwell Drive – for its entire length.

Chelsfield & Pratts Bottom

- Leamington Avenue – from its junction with Ashbourne Rise to its junction with Summerhill Close.

Chislehurst

- Albany Road – from its junction with Green Lane to its junction with Townshend Road.
- Degema Road – from its junction with Townshend Road southbound for its entire length.
- Windsor Close – for its entire length.

Clock House

- Clock House Road – from its junction with Queen's Road to its junction with Cedars Road.
- Colesburg Road – for its entire length.
- Hampden Avenue – from its junction with Belmont Road to Durban Road.
- Priory Close – for its entire length.

- Sefton Road – from its junction with Ascot Road to its junction with Sefton Close.

Darwin

- Ramus Wood Avenue – for its entire length.

- Bassetts Way – from its northern boundary with Starts Hill Road to its junction with Bassetts Close.

Hayes & Coney Hall

- Cherry Tree Walk – for its entire length.
- Everard Avenue – for its entire length.
- Hayes Wood Avenue – from its junction with George Lane to a point level with the southern boundary of 56 Hayes Wood Lane.

- Oakfield Gardens – for its entire length.

- Bickley Crescent – from its junction with Clarence Road to its junction with Rushmore Close.

- Samos Road – from its junction with Bourden Road to a point level with the northwestern boundary of 1 Samos Road.
- Turners Meadow Way – from a point level with northern boundary of 29 Turners Meadow Way northbound for the entire road.

- The Mead – in the street fronting properties 26 to 44 The Mead.

Cray Valley East

- Derry Downs – in the street fronting 37a to 37d Derry Downs.

Crystal Palace

- Ledrington Road – from the entrance to Crystal Palace Park northwards for its entire length.

- Harvest Bank Road – from its junction with Hartfield Road to a point level with the western boundary of 30 Harvest Bank Road.

- Goddard Road – Crescent section from its boundary 38 Goodard road to its boundary with 64 Goddard Road.

Orpington

- Allandale Place – for its entire length.
- Avalon Close – for its entire length.
- Orpington High Street (Orpington) – between its junctions with Station Road and Homefield Rise.

Penge & Cator

- Aldersmead Road – from its junction with Lennard Road to its junction with Ringwold Close.
- Bertie Road – for its entire length.
- Chaffinch Road – between its junctions with Rowden Road.
- Kenilworth Road – for its entire length.
- Montrave Road – for its entire length.
- Princes Road – for its entire length.
- Tennyson Road – for its entire length.

- Overhill Way – for its entire length.

West Wickham

- Manor Road – from its junction with Grosvenor Road to its junction with The Alders.

The following roads will be closed to through traffic at the times the signs are displayed between 8.00am and midnight on Saturday 18th June 2016:

Clock House

- Hampden Road – from its junction with Hampden Avenue to its junction with Cromwell Road.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect at 8.00am on Saturday 11th June 2016 and will end at Midnight on Saturday 11th June 2016, 8.00am on Sunday 12th June 2016 and will end at Midnight on Sunday 12th June 2016 and 8.00am on Saturday 18th June 2016 and will end at Midnight on Saturday 18th June 2016.
4. NOTHING in this order shall prevent pedestrian access at any time to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the order relates, or to any other premises which are assessable from such a road.
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate.

The Bromley (Controlled Parking) (On Street Places) Order 2004
(Amendment No. **) Order 2016.
(Victoria Road, Bromley)**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 19th April 2016 made the above-mentioned Order under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 2nd May 2016.

The effect of the Order would be to extend the existing permit parking scheme in Chatterton Village to include that section of Victoria Road as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Order may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Order.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Order was made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

SCHEDULE:-

RESIDENT PERMIT PARKING PLACES

Permit holders only between 12noon and 2pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive. Zone W. Residents Permits £40 per annum per vehicle:-

VICTORIA ROAD, Bromley, (a) the north side, (i) from a point 12m east of the eastern kerbline of Mosslea Road eastwards for a distance of 16m (3 parking spaces); (ii) from a point 3m east of the western flank wall of No. 29 eastwards to the eastern flank wall of No. 85 (approx. 27 parking spaces); (b) the south side, from a point 3m west of the party wall of Nos. 2 & 4 eastwards to the party wall of Nos. 64 & 66 (approx. 30 parking spaces).

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
