LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY
ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED – Section 14
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
BROMLEY AVENUE BROMLEY
NOTICE OF INTENTION

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Southern Gas Works to complete a gas main replacement THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Bromley Avenue Bromley will be closed to through traffic for up to four weeks at the junction with Farnaby Road Bromley

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Madeira Avenue
Highland Road
Beckenham Lane
Farnaby Road

2. THE Order will come into effect on Wednesday 3rd August 2016 with no specified finish date.
3. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
4. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times.
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times via the Madeira Avenue and Grasmere Road junctions with Bromley Avenue.
6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to four weeks to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
7. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley proposes to make the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (as amended) and all other enabling powers.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

(a) change the use of a Pay & Display parking bay in Elmfield Park, Bromley to a Car Club parking bay as specified in the Schedule to this notice;

(b) change the use of a Disabled parking bay in Knoll Rise, Orpington to a Car Club parking bay as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Details of prohibitions and exemptions for certain vehicles and persons are contained in the original Orders.

A copy of the proposed orders, of the plans of the schemes and of the Council's statement of reasons for proposing to make the Orders can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent.

ANY person wishing to object to the proposed Orders should send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds thereof to the Executive Director of Environment and Community Services, Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, BR1 3UH, quoting reference ADE(TP)/RP/T100/637 not later than 10th August 2016.

Persons objecting to the proposed orders should be aware that under the provisions of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, any comments received in response to this Notice may be open to public inspection.

SCHEDULE:-

CAR CLUB PLACES

At Any Time:-

ELMFIELD PARK, Bromley, the north to south arm, the west side, from a point 40.5m north of a point opposite the northern kerbline of the southernmost west to east arm of Elmfield Park northwards for a distance of 5m.

KNOLL RISE, Orpington, the north east side, from a point 13m north west of the north western kerbline of Berwick Way north westwards for a distance of 5.5m.
