JAIL LANE BIGGIN HILL
NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER**

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for UK Power Networks to make a new electricity connection to a property in Jail Lane Biggin Hill THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Jail Lane Biggin Hill will be closed to through traffic for two consecutive weekends starting at 07.00am on Saturday 12th November 2016 until 21.00pm on Sunday 13th November 2016 and 07.00am on Saturday 19th November 2016 until 21.00pm on Sunday 20th November 2016. The road will be closed close to Charles Darwin School.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Main Road A233
Leaves Green Road A233
Downe Road
New Road Hill
Rookery Road
High Street Downe
Luxted Road
Single Street

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Saturday 12th November 2016 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to two consecutive weekends to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer or Traffic Warden.
6. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
7. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate, vehicles will need to follow the diversion signs displayed on site. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 2nd November 2016 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 14th November 2016.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) introduce waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (b) introduce a Restricted Parking Zone as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (c) amend the existing shared use bays in Glebe Road, Bromley to allow resident permit holders to park, with no additional charge, during the Pay and Display operational hours;
- (d) amend the operational hours of the resident permit holder only bays in Aylesbury Road and Newbury Road, Bromley from 12noon-2pm Monday to Saturday to 11am-3pm Monday to Saturday;
- (e) introduce new disabled parking bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice;
- (f) remove the disabled parking bays as specified in the Schedule to this notice.

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

BARFIELD ROAD, Bickley, both sides, from the south western kerbline of Gosshill Road south westwards to a point 28m north east of the north eastern boundary of No. 28.

GOSSHILL ROAD, Chislehurst, the south west side, from a point 4m north west of a point opposite the common boundary of 'St. Alphage' and 'The Cottage' north westwards to a point 18m north west of a point opposite the north western flank wall of 'The Cottage'.

No Waiting between 1pm and 2pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive:-

GOSSHILL ROAD, Chislehurst, the north east side, from a point 9m north west of the common boundary of 'St. Alphage' and 'The Cottage' north westwards for a distance of 45m.

RESTRICTED PARKING ZONE

No Waiting or Loading between 1pm and 2pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive:-
GOSSHILL ROAD, Chislehurst, both sides, from a point 2m north west of the common boundary of 'St. Alphage' and 'The Cottage' south eastwards to its extremity.
