1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to enable the holding of Farnborough Village Christmas Lights Switch On Event and Street Markets on Sunday 27th November 2016 between 9am and 9pm THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions:

Farnborough High Street (Orpington) will be closed to through traffic between its junction eastern and western junctions with Ladycroft Way on Sunday 27th November 2016 between 9am and 9pm

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect at 9am on Sunday 27th November 2016 and will end at 9pm.
4. NOTHING in this Order shall prevent pedestrian access at any time to any premises situated on or adjacent to any road to which the Order relates, or to any other premises which are accessible from such a road.

6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to one night to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
