NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for UK Power Networks to make a new electricity connection to a property THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Plantation Drive Orpington will be closed to through traffic for up to five days at the junction with Quilter Road.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Quilter Road
Rye Crescent

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 28th November 2016 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the works will take up to five days to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.

7. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times.

TUBBENDEN LANE ORPINGTON**

NOTICE OF INTENTION

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order for Network Rail to make essential repairs to the railway bridge on Tubbenden Lane Orpington THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

Tubbenden Lane Orpington will be closed to through traffic for up to one day. The point of the closure will be at the railway bridge between Station Road and Sherlies Avenue.

Displaced traffic will be diverted via:-

Station Road
Crofton Road
Newstead Avenue
Ruskin Drive
Tubbenden Lane

2. THE Order will come into effect on Sunday 11th December 2016 with no specified finish date.
3. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
4. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of the closure as appropriate. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times.
6. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to one day to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order..
7. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2002.
