**Draft Addington CAAMP** The Council is inviting representations under Regulation 13 of the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012 on its draft Addington Conservation Area Appraisal Management Plan SPD. The CAAMP will be adopted as an SPD (as defined by the Planning and Compulsory Purchase Act 2004 (as amended) and the Town and Country Planning (Local Planning) (England) Regulations 2012) to give it weight as a material planning consideration when determining planning applications.
