NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER PUBLIC PATH DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 AND WILDLIFE AND COUNTRYSIDE ACT 1981 THE WILTSHIRE COUNCIL CHIPPENHAM WITHOUT 6 (PART) DIVERSION AND DEFINITIVE MAP AND STATEMENT MODIFICATION ORDER 2019

The named order, made on 5th June 2019, under section 257 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1990, will divert the public footpath at Chippenham Rugby Club, running from OS Grid Reference ST 8974 7413, in a north westerly direction for approximately 94 metres to ST 8969 7421 with a width of 0.3 metres to a new route at OS Grid Reference ST 8974 7413 leading in a northerly direction for approximately 80 metres and then in a westerly direction for approximately 52 metres to ST 8969 7421 having a width of 2 metres. If confirmed the Calne and Chippenham Rural District Council Area Definitive Map and statement dated 1953 shall be modified accordingly. Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Wiltshire Council has made an Order to close temporarily to all traffic: **Cross Lane (Part), Marlborough**; from property known as Princes Paddock, Cross Lane for a distance of approximately 70m in a north westerly direction to enable Thames Water to carry out a new
