TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC
ELMFIELD ROAD BROMLEY
NOTICE OF MAKING AN ORDER

1. The Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to allow safe traffic movements for deliveries and construction traffic into the construction site at the Prospect House premises at Elmfield Road, Bromley THEY HAVE MADE an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic: -
Temporary single yellow line parking restriction will replace the existing three pay and display parking spaces outside the Prospect House premises. This will be implemented at the front of Prospect House premises for approx. 25m along the eastern kerb line joining up with the existing permanent single yellow line restriction. The temporary Single Yellow Line restriction will be in place Monday – Saturday between the hours of 08:00-20:00 and on Sunday between the hours of 10:00-17:00.

Waiting Vehicles

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to stop outside the Prospect House premises for approx. 25m along the eastern kerb line between the hours of 08:00-20:00 Monday – Saturday and between the hours of 10:00-17:00 on Sunday.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Wednesday 20th April 2022 with no specified finish date.
4. ALTHOUGH the Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months, it is expected that the actual works will take up to 18 months to complete and will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. NOTHING in this Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or a Traffic Warden.
6. THE restriction referred to in this Order shall not apply to vehicles being used in connection with the work.
7. ACCESS to properties will be maintained at all times. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times. Pedestrian access will be available at all times during the works.
