**TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1990 SECTION 247
STOPPING UP OF HIGHWAY**

Part of the highway Sleaford Street London SW8

Wandsworth Council hereby gives notice that an Order is made under section 247 of the above Act entitled "The stopping up of Highways (London Borough of Wandsworth) (No.002) Order 2017, authorising the stopping up of part of the highway at Sleaford Street London SW8.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the **20 July 2017**, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

THE SCHEDULE

Description of highway to be stopped up

The highway to be stopped up is in the London Borough of Wandsworth and is shown line hatched in black on the deposited drawing 22764106_00002 and forms part of the highway at Sleaford Street London SW8.

Description of development

Application under Section 73 of the Town and Country Planning Act (as amended) for Amendments to planning permission (ref:2015/3555) dated 3 December 2015 (as amended by 19 April 2016 approval for non-material amendments under section 96A – ref 2016/2065) for the demolition of all existing buildings, and construction of seven new buildings of between 1-storey and 18-storeys, containing residential units; non-residential institution (D1) floorspace; business (B1) floorspace; retail/restaurant and café (A1/A3) floorspace); and an electricity substation. The proposals include vehicle/cycle parking, plant, the alteration of the vehicle access from Thessaly Road, and associated works and landscaping (The Amendments include the removal of the primary electricity substation; removal of the basement level; provision of car cycle parking at grade; replacement of flexible B1/C3 use on ground floor of Block A2 with B1 use and flexible A1/A3/B1 use; reconfiguration of health centre; revised finished floor level to block A1; reduction in footprint of block A2; minor alterations to elevations; and reconfiguration of internal layouts resulting in changes to unit and tenure mix and 12 additional residential units overall) An Environmental Statement has been submitted with the application under the Town and Country Planning (Environmental Impact Assessment) Regulations 2011 (as amended).
