1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth on 4th September 2017 made the above Orders under sections 9 and 10 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004.
2. The general effect of the Orders will be to designate electric vehicle parking places in the locations listed in the Schedule to this Notice for the leaving of electric vehicles only at all times for the purposes of charging the vehicle. The existing parking places will be amended as necessary. The existing electric vehicle charging points on Coverton Road, Grant Road and St John's Avenue will be replaced.

4. Copies of the Orders, which will come into operation on 18th September 2017, and of documents giving more detailed particulars of the Orders, can be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays inclusive until the end of a period of six months from the date on which the Orders were made in The Customer Centre, The Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London, SW18 2PU.
5. Copies of the Orders may be obtained from the Department of Environment and Community Services at the address given below.
6. Whilst the Orders remain in force the Assistant Director – Traffic and Engineering, or some person authorised by him, may modify or suspend the Orders or any provision contained in them if it appears to him or that other person essential in the interests of the expeditious, convenient and safe movement of traffic or of the provision of suitable and adequate parking facilities on the highway or for preserving or improving the amenities of the area through which any road affected by the Orders runs.
7. The Council will consider in due course whether the provisions of the Orders should be reproduced and continued in force indefinitely by means of Orders under section 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. Any person wishing to object to the making of Orders for the purpose of such reproduction and continuation may, within the above mentioned period of six months, send a statement in writing of their objection and the grounds on which it is made to the Director of Environment and Community Services at the address below (quoting the reference ES/TMO1654).
8. Any person desiring to question the validity of the Orders or of any provision contained in them on the grounds that it is not within the relevant powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 or that any of the relevant requirements of that Act or of any relevant regulations made under that Act have not been complied with in relation to the Orders may, within six weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

Bramfield Road	The north-west side, 2 bays alongside the south-eastern wall of No. 140 Northcote Road
Brudenell Street	The south-west side, 3 bays opposite Nos. 7 to 12 Bruce Hall Mews
Clonmore Street	The west side, 3 bays alongside the eastern wall of No. 42 Replingham Road
Coverton Road	The south-west side, 2 bays opposite Nos. 102 and 104 Coverton Road
Grant Road	The north side, 5 bays east of its junction with Winstanley Road
Haldane Place	The north side, 5 bays west of the junction with Garratt Lane
Openview	The north-east side, 3 bays north-west of the junction with Burntwood Lane
Prince of Wales Drive	The north-west side, 3 bays opposite All Saints Church
Rectory Lane	The north-west side, 3 bays opposite Nos. 12 to 15 Rectory Lane
Sistova Road	The north side, 3 bays alongside the southern boundary of No. 47 Bedford Hill
St John's Avenue	The north side, 3 bays alongside the southern boundary of No. 32a Putney Hill
