ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984,

COLLEGE GREEN, UPPER NORWOOD
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF PARKING

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate the siting of refuse and recycling bins, skips and a temporary site toilet whilst works are carried out at Nos. 98 to 176 College Green, they have made an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily suspend parking and introduce waiting and loading restrictions operating "at any time" in part of College Green.
2. Whilst the provisions of the Order remain in force, waiting or loading by vehicles will be prohibited at any time in the inset parking bay on the north-east side of College Green, adjacent to Nos. 98 to 176 College Green. Any vehicle waiting in contravention of a waiting restriction imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
3. The Order will come into operation on the 21 September 2017 and it is anticipated that the works will be carried out in approximately seven weeks. However, the Order will remain in force for 18 months to be reintroduced should further works be required.
(Note: The provisions of the Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.

TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
TAMWORTH PLACE, CROYDON

1. Croydon Council, **HEREBY GIVE NOTICE** that to facilitate re-development works in Cairo New Road, they intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to:
 - (a) temporarily close Tamworth Place (between its junctions with Tamworth Road and Drummond Road) at its junction with Drummond Road between 10am and 3pm when required;
 - (b) temporarily ban vehicles from turning right from Drummond Road into Tamworth Place (between its junctions with Tamworth Road and Drummond Road) when that section of Tamworth Place is closed.

2. During the prohibition referred to above, displaced traffic will be diverted via Drummond Road, Reeves Corner and Tamworth Road.
3. The Order will come into operation on the 19 October 2017 and will remain in force until completion of the works. (Note: The provisions of the Order will only apply during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016. (Access for frontagers will be maintained as far as possible whilst the work proceeds).

(TEMPORARY RESTRICTIONS) ACT 1991
TYLECROFT ROAD, NORBURY
TEMPORARY RESTRICTION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC

1. Croydon Council **HEREBY GIVES NOTICE** that to facilitate gas works being carried out, they intend to make an Order to the effect of which would be to temporarily restrict vehicular parking in Tylecroft Road, Norbury.
2. Whilst the said works are taking place temporary waiting and loading restrictions will be introduced 'At any time' outside and opposite nos.4 to 10 Tylecroft Road, Norbury.
