### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) BOND GARDENS

1. The Council of the London Borough of Sutton hereby gives notice that in order to install a new electricity supply to new flats and because works are being executed near the road it made an Order the effect of which is summarised in paragraph 3 below.
2. The Order will come into effect on **Monday 23 October 2017**, with works expected to take 5 days to complete. However the Order will remain in force for 3 months to be re-introduced should further works be required.
3. When the works are taking place and the appropriate traffic signs are displayed the Order will temporarily in **Bond Gardens** – 'no waiting at any time' and loading restrictions 'no loading / unloading at any time'.
4. Any vehicle that is in contravention of the temporary waiting & loading restrictions at a time When these restrictions apply will be removed to an alternative location in accordance with the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986.
5. **The prohibitions specified above apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.**

### ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 - SECTION 14(1) TEMPORARY CLOSURE OF PUBLIC FOOTPATH (PROW No. 105)

1. The Council of the London Borough of Sutton hereby gives notice that in order to facilitate exposure of underground electric cables, it intends to make an Order the effect of which will be to temporarily close the footpath **public right of way No. 105** running between **Bernard Road and Manor Road, Wallington**.
2. The closure of that path will come into effect on **Friday 17 November, 2017** with works expected to take 10 days to complete. However, the Order will remain in force for 6 months to be re-introduced should further works be required.
3. A diversion route for pedestrians will be via Manor Road, Wallington, Queens Road, Parkgate Road and vice versa.
4. The prohibitions specified above apply only during such times and to such extent as indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
