BAHRAM ROAD (D2026), EPSOM
TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC
ORDER 2017

ON 15TH NOVEMBER 2017 SURREY COUNTY COUNCIL MADE the above mentioned Temporary Order under Section 14(1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit vehicles from entering or proceeding in the entire length of Bahram Road (D2026), Epsom. The Order is required to enable A and L Chapman Ltd. to make a new foul sewer connection. These works are anticipated to be carried out within one week of the twelve month period of operation of the Temporary Order, which commences on 20th November 2017. Advanced warning signs will be displayed and the temporary closure which is anticipated will be required for 24 hours each day, will only operate when the relevant traffic signs are displayed. Access for pedestrians, cyclists and equestrians will be maintained at all times; cyclists and equestrians will be required to dismount and follow the pedestrian walk way. No sole access will be affected however access will be maintained at all times for residences, businesses and emergency services via the signed diversion route which will be Harvester Road, Nimbus Road and Barham Road.
