## MINOR PARKING AMENDMENTS

### FONTENOY ROAD, HENDERSON ROAD, MALWOOD ROAD, ROSEHILL ROAD, WIMBLEDON PARK ROAD

1. NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Wandsworth proposes to make the following Orders under sections 6, 45, 46, 49 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by the Local Government Act 1985 and the Traffic Management Act 2004:
  - *The Wandsworth (Waiting and Loading Restriction) (Special Parking Areas)*
  - *(Amendment No. \*) Order 2018*
  - *The Wandsworth (Clapham South) (Parking Places) (No. \*) Order 2018*
  - *The Wandsworth (Southfields) (Parking Places) (No. \*) Order 2018*
  - *The Wandsworth (Wandsworth Common) (Parking Places) (No. \*) Order 2018*
  - *The Wandsworth (Wandsworth Town) (Parking Places) (No. \*) Order 2018*
2. The general effect of the Orders would be:
  - (a) in Fontenoy Road, to remove 5 metres of parking place outside No. 1 Fontenoy Road to accommodate a new vehicle crossover. A single yellow line waiting restriction operating between 9.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays would be provided at this location;
  - (b) in Henderson Road, to remove 11 metres of parking place outside Nos. 30 to 40, Henderson Court, Henderson Road to accommodate a new vehicle crossover. A single yellow line waiting restriction operating between 11.00am and midday on Mondays to Saturdays would be provided at this location;
  - (c) in Malwood Road, to reinstate the shared use parking place outside No. 1 Malwood Road that would operate between 9.30am and 5.30pm on Mondays to Fridays;
  - (d) in Rosehill Road, to remove 6 metres of parking place adjacent to No. 36 Geraldine Road to accommodate a new vehicle crossover. A single yellow line waiting restriction operating between 9.30am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays would be provided at this location; and
  - (e) in Wimbledon Park Road, to remove 6.5 metres of parking place outside No. 196 Wimbledon Park Road to accommodate a new vehicle crossover. A single yellow line waiting restriction operating between 9.30am and 4.30pm on Mondays to Fridays would be provided at this location.
3. Copies of documents giving more detailed particulars of the proposed Orders are available for inspection during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays in The Customer Centre, The Town Hall, Wandsworth High Street, London, SW18 2PU. The documents will remain available until the end of six weeks from the date on which the Orders are made or, as the case may be, the Council decides not to make the Orders.
