(VARIOUS ROADS – WEST OXFORDSHIRE)

(PROHIBITION AND RESTRICTION OF WAITING AND PERMITTED PARKING) (VARIATION NO.***) ORDER 20**

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council proposes to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and all other enabling powers. The Order will further amend the Oxfordshire County Council (Various Roads – West Oxfordshire) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting and Permitted Parking) order 2012. The effect of the proposal is to:

1.) Change 'No Waiting at Any Time' (DYLs – double yellow lines) in the following areas in **Bampton** village:

- High Street – to extend the DYLs eastwards from the roundabout to cover planned road narrowing 'build-outs' from each kerb (outside the Co-op) to prevent unlawful parking which causes obstruction at this point;
- Broad Street – west side – remove DYLs northwards from its junction with Church Street and around the northern kerb line into Church Street;
- Church Street – south side – shorten the 20 metres length to 6 metres;
- Rosemary Lane – south side – introduce new DYLs from its junction with Bridge Street westwards for 15metres.

2). To create a general parking place (marked bay) with no time limit in Cheapside, northeast side from the eastern property boundary of "Old George" eastwards for 5.5metres, wholly upon the footway.

HIGH STREET (BAMPTON) – PROPOSED CROSSING POINT ENHANCEMENT

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Oxfordshire County Council under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 & the Highways Act 1980 also proposes to construct the following traffic feature on **High Street**:

- Informal crossing point – located approx. 30 metres east of the junction with the A4095: measuring approx. 10.5 metres long & 1.8 metre wide narrowing the northbound carriageway, with ramped crossing points to aid those with restricted mobility.

* All dimensions are approximate and if specified, taken from the centre of the junction to the centre of the feature.
