LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984 AS AMENDED - SECTION 14 (1) (c) TEMPORARY PROHIBITION OF VEHICULAR TRAFFIC NOTICE OF INTENTION VARIOUS ROADS WITHIN THE LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY

1. THE Council of the London Borough of Bromley HEREBY GIVE NOTICE that in order to for Southern Gas Networks (SGN) to complete gas main replacement works in the streets listed in the Schedule below THEY INTEND to make an Order the effect of which will be to impose the following restrictions on vehicular traffic:-

(1) WAITING VEHICLES

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to wait in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street or part of a street adjacent thereto as may become necessary.

Any vehicle waiting in contravention of any restriction on waiting imposed by this Order may be removed under the provisions of the Removal and Disposal of Vehicles Regulations 1986, or by the Council in accordance with the powers conferred upon it.

(2) PROHIBITION OF TRAFFIC

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto.

(3) ONE-WAY WORKING

No person shall, until the works are completed, cause or permit any vehicle to proceed in any street specified in the Schedule to this Notice, or any other street adjacent thereto, in a direction other than that indicated by traffic signs.

NB:During the prohibitions at (2) and (3) above, displaced traffic will be diverted via local streets as appropriate.

NB:The above prohibitions at (3) will not apply to cul-de-sacs.

2. THE prohibitions referred to in Paragraph 1 above shall apply only during such times and to such extent as shall from time to time be indicated by traffic signs prescribed by the Traffic Signs Regulations and General Directions 2016.
3. THE Order will come into effect on Monday 13th February 2017 with no specified finish date.
4. THE Order will have a maximum duration of 18 months and the works will begin on or after the commencement date of the Order.
5. ACCESS to properties will be maintained as far as is practicable from either side of closures as appropriate. Emergency access and egress routes will be maintained at all times.
6. NOTHING in the Order shall apply to vehicles being used in connection with the works.
7. NOTHING in the Order shall apply to anything done with the permission or direction of a Police Officer in uniform or Traffic Warden.

LONDON BOROUGH OF BROMLEY The Bromley (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 2003 (Amendment No. 167) Order 2017. The Bromley (Controlled Parking) (On Street Places) Order 2004 (Amendment No. 91) Order 2017. (Various Locations)

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Council of the London Borough of Bromley on 10th January 2017 made the above-mentioned Orders under Sections 6, 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by Section 8 of and Part 1 of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985, and of all other powers thereunto enabling, which will come into operation on 30th January 2017.

The effect of the Orders would be to:-

- (a) introduce/extend/remove waiting restrictions as specified in the Schedule to this notice;**
- (b) introduce free parking places as specified in the Schedule to this notice;**
- (c) remove two Pay & Display/Permit bays in Copers Cope Road, Beckenham adjacent to Urquhart Court, Park Road and replace with 'At Any Time' waiting restrictions.**

A copy of the Orders may be inspected during normal office hours on Mondays to Fridays at the Bromley Civic Centre, Stockwell Close, Bromley, Kent until the expiration of a period of 6 weeks from the date of making the Orders.

ANY person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or of any of their provisions on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any relevant regulations made thereunder has not been complied with, may within 6 weeks from the date on which the Orders were made, make application for the purpose to the High Court.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

BOURNE VALE, Hayes, the north west side, from the southern flank wall of No. 75 northwards to the party wall of Nos. 77 & 79.
CHIPPERFIELD ROAD, St. Paul's Cray, the west side, from a point 18m south of the southern kerbline of Mickleham Road northwards to a point 2m south of a point opposite the southern kerbline of Cotmandene Crescent.
COMMONSIDE, Keston, the east side, from the southern kerbline of Stour Close southwards for a distance of 7m.
COPERS COPE ROAD, Beckenham, (a) the north and east sides, (i) from a point 13m south east of the south eastern kerbline of Lawn Road north westwards to a point 4m south of the northern boundary of Copers Grange; (ii) from a point 28m south of the southern kerbline of Park Road northwards to a point opposite the southern boundary of No. 85; (b) the south and west side, from a point 8m north west of the north western kerbline of Sellindge Close north westwards to a point 2m south east of the northern boundary of Knewleave House.
CRANMORE ROAD, Chislehurst, both sides, from the south western kerbline of White Horse Hill south westwards for a distance of 12m.
GREYS PARK CLOSE, Keston, both sides, from the north eastern kerbline of Heathfield Road north eastwards for a distance of 15m.
HARLEYFORD, Bromley, both sides, from a point 9m east of the eastern flank wall of No. 9 Upper Park Road westwards to its extremity.
HAWES LANE, West Wickham, the north east side, from a point 8m north west of the north western kerbline of Phoenix Close south eastwards to a point 11m south east of the south eastern kerbline of Phoenix Close.
HAWKWOOD LANE, Chislehurst, the north west side, from a point 10m north east of the north eastern kerbline of Morley Road south westwards to a point 21m south west of the south western kerbline of Morley Road.
HEATHFIELD ROAD, Keston, the north east side, from a point 10m north

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west of the north western kerbline of Greys Park Close south eastwards to a point 6m south east of the south eastern kerbline of Greys Park Close.
MICKLEHAM ROAD, St. Paul's Cray, the south side, from the western kerbline of Chipperfield Road westwards for a distance of 11m.
MOUNTHURST ROAD, Hayes, the north side, from a point 6m west of the western kerbline of Pembury Close eastwards to a point 15m east of the eastern kerbline of Pembury Close.

OAKLANDS ROAD, Bromley, (a) the south east side, from a point 6.5m south west of the eastern flank wall of Flats 4-6, Bromley Court south westwards for a distance of 12.5m; (b) the north west side, from the common boundary of Linden Court and Sedgwick Court south westwards for a distance of 5m.
PEMBURY CLOSE, Hayes, (a) the west side, from the northern kerbline of Mounthurst Road northwards for a distance of 13m; (b) the east side, from the northern kerbline of Mounthurst Road northwards for a distance of 19m.
PHOENIX CLOSE, West Wickham, both sides, from the north eastern kerbline of Hawes Lane north eastwards for a distance of 12m.

REED AVENUE, Orpington, (a) the north west side, from the north eastern kerbline of Tile Farm Road north eastwards for a distance of 8m; (b) both sides, from the south eastern kerbline of Willersley Avenue south eastwards for a distance of 15m.

SANDY BURY, Orpington, the north west side, from the south western kerbline of Tile Farm Road south westwards for a distance of 13m.

TILE FARM ROAD, Orpington, (a) the north east side, from the common boundary of Nos. 10 & 12 south eastwards to a point 20m south east of the south eastern kerbline of Reed Avenue; (b) the south west side, from the common boundary of Nos. 9 & 13 south eastwards to the common boundary of Nos. 3 & 5.

TREVOR CLOSE, Hayes, both sides, from the north western kerbline of Bourne Vale westwards for a distance of 12m.

WHITE HORSE HILL, Chislehurst, the south west side, from the party wall of Nos. 165 & 167 north westwards to the party wall of Nos. 169 & 171.

WILLERSLEY AVENUE, Orpington, the south east side, from a point 9m south west of the south western kerbline of Reed Avenue north eastwards to a point 11m north east of the north eastern kerbline of Reed Avenue.

MERTON GARDENS, Petts Wood, the sides fronting Nos. 1 to 36, from a point 10m south west of the south western kerbline of Crest View Drive clockwise to a point 10m north east of the north eastern kerbline of Crest View Drive.

No Waiting between 8am and 5pm on Mondays to Fridays inclusive:-
MERTON GARDENS, Petts Wood, surrounding the island site opposite Nos. 1 to 36.

WAITING RESTRICTIONS – REMOVALS

No Waiting At Any Time:-

WARING CLOSE, Orpington, both sides, from a point 3m west of the common boundary of Nos. 5 & 7 westwards for a distance of 4m.

FREE PARKING PLACES

MERTON GARDENS, Petts Wood, the sides fronting Nos. 1 to 36, from a point 10m south west of the south western kerbline of Crest View Drive clockwise to a point 13m north east of the north eastern kerbline of Crest View Drive (approx. 20 parking spaces).

OAKLANDS ROAD, Bromley, the south east side, from a point 6.5m south west of the eastern flank wall of Flats 4-6, Bromley Court north eastwards for a distance of 10m (2 parking spaces).
